**RESOLUTION ON CONVERTING FOUR SPECIFIC
ONE-WAY STREETS TO TWO-WAY STREETS**

WHEREAS, The District Department of Transportation (DDOT) has permanently removed the eastbound on ramp to the Southeast-Southwest Freeway at the corner of Virginia Avenue SE and 9th Street SE as part of the 11th Street Bridge project;

WHEREAS, The following local streets in the area were apparently set up as one-way streets to facilitate access to that on ramp: 800 blocks of Virginia Avenue and L Street SE, and 1000 and 1100 blocks of 9th Street SE;

WHEREAS, This traffic circulation makes no sense with the closure of the on-ramp, especially given pending development projects in the immediate area that will generate more local traffic; and

WHEREAS, Advisory Neighborhood Commission 6B (ANC 6B) has raised this matter at quarterly meetings of the 11th Street Bridge Community Communications Committee and has discussed it directly with DDOT staff;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, That ANC 6B requests that DDOT convert the aforementioned one-way streets to two-way streets; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, That ANC 6B voted 9-0 at a regularly scheduled meeting with a quorum present to authorize the Commission's Chair to transmit this Resolution to DDOT.
